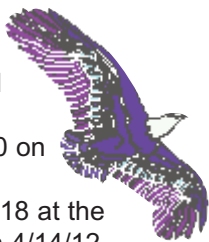

Player of the Year Points System

MAJORS – Minimum 5 points for playing, 1 point for every person beaten in flight, additional 3 for overall champions, additional 5 for overall CMI champion

- Club Championship (max 11 for non-overall champ)
- Chick Miler Invitational (7 for playing, max 15 for non-overall champ)
- Match Play Championship (1 point per round advanced)

MID-MAJORS – Minimum 3 points for playing, 1 point for every person beaten in flight excluding President's Cups (non-flighted, top five receive 2 bonus points – additional 2 for overall champions)

- Men's Member-Member (4 for playing, 3 bonus points for winning flight, additional 2 bonus points for overall champion)
- Men's Member-Guest (4 for playing, 3 bonus points for winning flight, additional 2 bonus points for overall champion)
- Senior Club Championship (max 7 non-overall champ, due to age requirement to participate)
- Senior President's Cup (max 7)
- Cuthbert Cup (4 points for playing, 2 bonus points for placing, additional 2 bonus points for net champion and gross champion)

MINORS – 2 points for playing, 1 for winning flight, bonus 2 for overall champion, maximum 5 points

- Superbowl Powerball (3 for playing)
- Shamble (1 point per shamble played, max 3)
- One Day Club Tournaments

- o A \$10 finance charge will be added to all unpaid balances each month.
- o We will be enforcing the DRESS CODE. Please wear collared shirts ... and tuck in shirt tails! NO cut-off jeans.
- o Tennis court reservations will be made at Miler Pro Shop.
- o Members observed riding on carts without checking in the Pro Shop for proper payment will be assessed a cart rental for 18 holes - no exceptions!
- o A valid driver's license is required to drive a golf cart.
- o Observing cart path rules is critical to the maintenance of the course!
- o Please have your membership card available when using the facilities ... this includes children 7+.
- o Cart fees are charged per rider per 18 holes. Additional holes require additional payment. No cart will be rented for less than \$16.00 for 18 holes.
- o Please call ahead for tee times, which are required seven days a week.
- o Please sign-in at Pro Shop before playing golf or tennis. Have your membership card available when signing in; if you don't have one, call the office for replacement cards.
- o For slow-playing groups, please allow other groups waiting behind you to play through.
- o Do NOT tee off on #10 first WITHOUT checking in the Pro Shop. Tee times are arranged for groups to start on #1 tee.
- o **Please do not leave your children unattended in the clubhouse. No one under the age of 21 is allowed in the bar after 4:30 pm unless attending a club special event.**

To post your score online, go to:

www.golfnet.com

and click on GOLFER TOOLS at top of page on golfnet website.

Select GOLFER LOG IN.

UNLESS you have created a unique golfer id and password - enter your current golfer id number (no suffix needed at the moment) as the user name. Enter milercc for the password (case sensitive now-all lower case and no spaces). Once logged on, follow tabs at top of golfer page to post.

MySCGA Login & Online Tournament Registration

With a one-time registration, individual monthly handicap indexes can be emailed at each revision. Along with an updated handicap index, each email includes your last 20-score history, the latest in SCGA and CGA news, a cut-out handicap card, and more!
