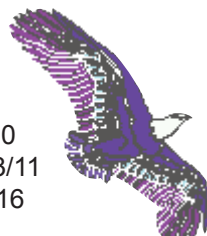

I've been receiving a lot of questions on handicaps and course ratings lately so I contacted the SCGA for assistance. A course rating team will be coming out to the course to do a re-rate sometime in April – this is standard every five years. As far as handicaps, it seems it may take a few months of revisions to return to normal. The best advice I can offer is to accurately enter all scores regardless if they are good or bad – remember any player that accurately enters all scores will receive the handicap in the computer – if there is any discrepancy, no matter how small, then that player is at the mercy of the handicap committee for handicap tournaments.

36-hole stroke play, flighted after round one. Open Club Champion will be determined by the two-day low gross total. President's Cup Champion will be determined by the two-day low NET total.

Entry fee - \$35 plus cart fees. Gift certificates and credit can be used for cart fees but not entry fees.

Saturday - Bag lunch during play available in bar, includes soda.

Sunday - Lunch, fountain drinks, iced tea, draft beer and awards following play.

Closest to Pin: Two chances each day for \$10 toal

PLAYER OF THE YEAR POINTS SYSTEM

MAJORS - Minimum 5 points for playing, 1 point for every person beaten in flight, additional 3 for overall champions, additional 5 for overall CMI champion

- Club Championship (max 11 for non-overall champ)
- Chick Miler Invitational (7 for playing, max 15 for non-overall champ)
- Match Play Championship (1 point per round advanced)

MID MAJORS - Minimum 3 point for playing, 1 point for every person beaten in flight excluding President's Cups (non-flighted, top five receive 2 bonus points - additional 2 for overall champions)

- Men's Member Member (4 for playing, 3 bonus points for winning flight, additional 2 bonus points for overall champion)
- Senior Club Championship (max 7 non-overall champ, due to age requirement to participate)
- Senior Senior President's Cup (max 7)
- Open President's Cup (max 7)
- Cuthbert Cup (4 points for playing, 2 bonus points for placing, additional 2 bonus points for net champion and gross champion)

MINORS - 2 points for playing, 1 for winning flight, bonus 2 for overall champion, maximum 5 points

- Superbowl Powerball (3 for playing)
- Shamble (1 point per shamble played, max 3)
- One-day Club Tournaments

Reminders & Notices

- o A \$10 finance charge will be added to all unpaid balances each month.
- o We will be enforcing the DRESS CODE. Please wear collared shirts ... and tuck in shirt tails! NO cut-off jeans.
- o Tennis court reservations will be made at Miler Pro Shop.
- o Members observed riding on carts without checking in the Pro Shop for proper payment will be assessed a cart rental for 18 holes - no exceptions!
- o A valid driver's license is required to drive a golf cart.
- o Observing cart path rules is critical to the maintenance of the course!
- o Please have your membership card available when using the facilities ... this includes children 7+.
- o Cart fees are charged per rider per 18 holes. Additional holes require additional payment. No cart will be rented for less than \$16.00 for 18 holes.

- o Please sign-in at Pro Shop before playing golf or tennis. Have your membership card available when signing in; if you don't have one, call the office for replacement cards.
- o For slow-playing groups, please allow other groups waiting behind you to play through.
- o Do NOT tee off on #10 first WITHOUT checking in the Pro Shop. Tee times are arranged for groups to start on #1 tee.
- o Please do not leave your children unattended in the clubhouse. No one under the age of 21 is allowed in the bar after 4:30 pm unless attending a club special event.
