The 9 hole Shamble will be held twice a month (2nd and 4th Wednesday each month) through August beginning April 9. The \$20 fee includes cart. Remember to call the pro shop by 5:00 p.m. with your two man team players and be ready to tee off by 6:00 p.m.

The sign up for the Summer Match Play is also in the pro shop and it's looking like we may have enough interest to do an open bracket as well as a senior bracket.

Devvy Walker and Ellie Sims have brought forth the idea of a 9 hole couples golf event once a month. We will host the first event April 14 - Monday after the Masters and encourage all couples, any skill level, to sign up and enjoy a fun round of golf as entry will only be \$5.

Speaking of the Masters, I've had some requests to bring back the Masters Pool so once the field is finalized be on the lookout for the entry sheets - format will be like we did two years ago where you pick 7 players and take the 5 best 72 hole scores - if less than 5 make the cut you are out.

Also during Masters week we will do the Spring Forward sale where I have many specials for members only planned. We will do the shoe special on Nike and Footjoy shoes and also do custom shirt specials. These specials will start and end with the Masters Tournament.

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Reminders & Notices

- o **A \$10 finance charge will be added to all unpaid balances each month.**
- o We will be enforcing the DRESS CODE. Please wear collared shirts ... and tuck in shirt tails! NO cut-off jeans.
- o Please have your membership card available when using the facilities.
- o Please call ahead for tee times, which are required seven days a week.
- o Check in at the Pro Shop before teeing off.
- o Do NOT tee off on #10 first WITHOUT checking in the Pro Shop. Tee times are arranged for groups to start on #1 tee.
- o Members observed riding on carts without checking in the Pro Shop for proper payment will be assessed a cart rental for 18 holes - no exceptions!
- o A valid driver's license is required to drive a golf cart.
- o Observing cart path rules is critical to the maintenance of the course!
- o Cart fees are charged per rider per 18 holes. Additional holes require additional payment.
- o For slow-playing groups, please allow other groups waiting behind you to play through.
- o **Please do not leave your children unattended in the clubhouse. No one under the age of 21 is allowed in the bar after 4:30 pm unless attending a club special event.**

NOTICE FOR MEMBERS as of 3/10/2014

The loyalty program began adding points to your account in February. One loyalty point is earned for each dollar spent on golf carts, user fees, and pro shop merchandise (food & bev. not included at this time). Monthly membership dues do not qualify for loyalty points; however, if you pay one full year's dues in lump sum you will receive one point per dollar paid in dues.

Loyalty Points (Rewards) may be redeemed as follows:

18 hole cart – 250 points (user fee not included)
9 hole cart – 130 points (user fee not included)
350 points – take an additional 30% off any one "in stock" merchandise item (this amounts to 40% total discount –your daily 10% + 30% additional)-special orders do not apply (a manual point adjustment will be made when this special discount is used).

MEMBER 9 HOLE CART RATE CHANGE & SPECIALS:

The NEW rate for a 9 hole member cart is \$10.00.

The 18 hole cart rate will remain at \$16.00.

NEW TWILITE MEMBER CART

Beginning at 4 PM each day, a member may ride up to 18 holes for \$10.00.

TUESDAY MEMBER CART SPECIAL
For all members-\$10.00 cart rental for 18 holes at any time.

WEDNESDAY SENIOR MEMBER CART SPECIAL

Ages 55+ \$10.00 cart rental for 18 holes at any time.
