Reminders & Notices

- o **A \$10 finance charge will be added to all unpaid balances each month.**
- o We will be enforcing the DRESS CODE. Please wear collared shirts ... and tuck in shirt tails! NO cut-off jeans.
- o Please have your membership card available when using the facilities.
- o Please call ahead for tee times, which are required seven days a week.
- o Check in at the Pro Shop before teeing off.
- o Do NOT tee off on #10 first WITHOUT checking in the Pro Shop. Tee times are arranged for groups to start on #1 tee.
- o **Members observed riding on carts without checking in the Pro Shop for proper payment will be assessed a cart rental for 18 holes - no exceptions!**
- o A valid driver's license is required to drive a golf cart.
- o Observing cart path rules is critical to the maintenance of the course!
- o Cart fees are charged per rider per 18 holes. Additional holes require additional payment.
- o For slow-playing groups, please allow other groups waiting behind you to play through.
- o **Please do not leave your children unattended in the clubhouse. No one under the age of 21 is allowed in the bar after 4:30 pm unless attending a club special event.**

o Tips added to snackbar charges do not count as part of the food & beverage minimum.

Loyalty Points & Cart Specials

The loyalty program began adding points to your account in February. One loyalty point is earned for each dollar spent on golf carts, user fees, and pro shop merchandise (food & bev. not included at this time). Monthly membership dues do not qualify for loyalty points; however, if you pay one full year's dues in lump sum you will receive one point per dollar paid in dues. UNUSED loyalty points expire annually at midnight on Dec 31.

Loyalty Points (Rewards) may be redeemed as follows:

18 hole cart – 250 points (user fee not included)

9 hole cart – 130 points (user fee not included)

350 points – take an additional 30% off any one "in stock" merchandise item (this amounts to 40% total discount –your daily 10% + 30% additional)-special orders do not apply (a manual point adjustment will be made when this special discount is used).

MEMBER 9 HOLE CART RATE CHANGE & SPECIALS:

The NEW rate for a 9 hole member cart is \$10. The 18 hole cart rate will remain at \$16.

NEW TWILITE MEMBER CART - Beginning at 4 PM each day, a member may ride up to 18 holes for \$10.

TUESDAY MEMBER CART SPECIAL - All members-\$10 cart rental for 18 holes anytime.

WEDNESDAY SENIOR MEMBER CART SPECIAL - Ages 55+ \$10.00 cart rental for 18 holes at any time.
