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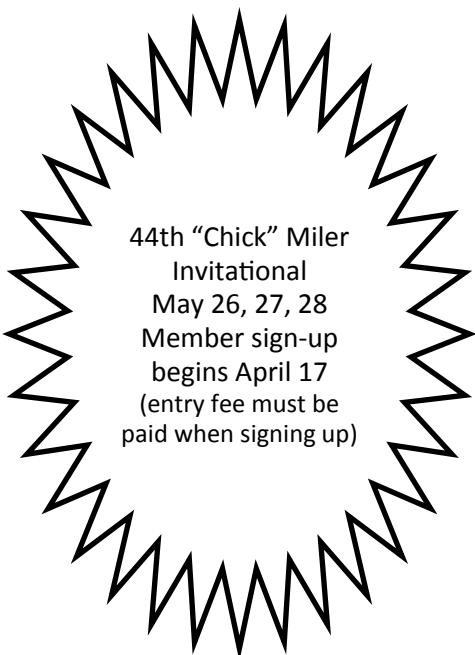
From the Office

Welcome spring! The beautiful weather and the upcoming Masters tournament surely gets us excited for golf. Our new guest rates are in effect now and are posted in the pro shop. The only "tweak" in member rates will be for the 9 hole golf cart fees beginning April 1, 2017. Our 9 hole cart rate and twilight cart fee for all members will increase from \$10 to \$12. The 18 hole member cart rate will remain at \$16. We will have a weekly **cart special for all members** on Tuesday and Wednesday for \$12 to ride up to 18 holes. The twilight member cart fee will begin at 3PM every day (members ride up to 18 holes for \$12-no rainchecks after 3:00). We appreciate your support and hope we continue to attract outside play while making membership a true value as you are to us. Increasing expenses continue to challenge our business industry and we are

working hard to keep your costs down. Our membership referral program remains in effect and you can earn up to \$100 per new member you sign up. However, the reduced golf rate reciprocal agreement with Berkeley Country Club is no longer in effect due to new management at Berkeley.

Our pro shop hours are 6AM to 6PM (latest time to rent a cart)-friendly reminder to have carts in before dark for your safety and a courtesy to our cart staff. Our snackbar opens at 10AM and the grill generally closes at 6 (the bar hours fluctuate based on weather and crowds, we appreciate your patronage). We will be open regular hours on Easter Sunday.

I'm looking forward to the start of our major tournament season as well as the start of the PGA tour major season - and lastly remember to fill out your Masters bracket before 9 am April 6!

LOYALTY NOTICE FOR MEMBERS

Loyalty points reset on Jan 1 each year.

UNUSED points expire annually midnight on Dec. 31.

One loyalty point is earned for each dollar spent on golf carts, user fees, and pro shop merchandise (tax, food & beverage not included at this time). DUES EARN POINTS ALSO!

LOYALTY POINTS (REWARDS) may be redeemed as follows:

18 hole cart – 350 points (\$2.00 user fee not included)

9 hole cart – 200 points (\$2.00 user fee not included)

Guest fee – 350 points (\$4.00 user fee + cart not included)

Merchandise:

Clothing-400 points=40% total discount

Golf balls + gloves-400 points=20% total discount

In stock golf clubs, shoes + special orders must see Bray for pricing

400 points = pay cost + 10%

A manual point adjustment will be made for merchandise discounts.
