LOYALTY POINTS (REWARDS) may be redeemed as
follows:

18 hole cart – 350 points (\$2.00 user fee not
included)

9 hole cart – 200 points (\$2.00 user fee not included)

Guest fee – 350 points (\$4.00 user fee + cart not
included)

Merchandise:

Clothing-400 points=40% total discount

Golf balls + gloves-400 points=20% total discount

In stock golf clubs, shoes + special orders must see
Bray for pricing

400 points = pay cost + 10%

A manual point adjustment will be made for
merchandise discounts.
