LOYALTY NOTICE FOR MEMBERS

Loyalty points reset on Jan 1 each year.

UNUSED points expire annually midnight on Dec. 31.

One loyalty point is earned for each dollar spent on golf carts, user fees, and pro shop merchandise (tax, food & beverage not included at this time). DUES EARN POINTS ALSO!

LOYALTY POINTS (REWARDS) may be redeemed as follows:

18 hole cart – 350 points (\$2.00 user fee not included)
9 hole cart – 200 points (\$2.00 user fee not included)
Guest fee – 350 points (\$4.00 user fee + cart not included)

Merchandise:

Clothing-400 points=40% total discount
Golf balls + gloves-400 points=20% total discount
In stock golf clubs, shoes + special orders must see Bray for pricing
400 points = pay cost + 10%
A manual point adjustment will be made for merchandise discounts.

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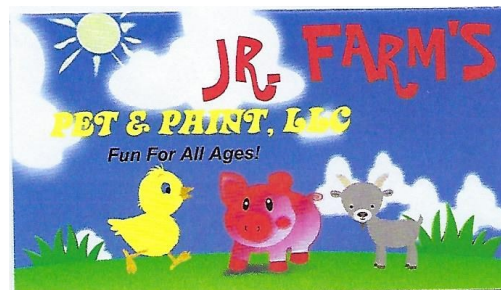
