Crystal loved serving others, building relationships and sharing her charismatic and outgoing personality with everyone around her. It's no surprise Crystal found her niche in the hospitality industry. Her passion and drive to create memorable experiences reached far beyond her bar regulars. She never encountered a stranger because her love for people exuded a sense of belonging and her incredible ability to engage and bring people together with that bright, contagious smile and quirky demeanor made her such a special and unique woman.
