Just a quick reminder about the statements you receive-daily sales invoices print full detail now and the software will not allow me to summarize each charge. If you follow each daily sale amount in the debit column you will notice payment method (credit) at the end of the total invoice if you paid by cash, check or credit card. If you do not see a payment method for the day's invoice then those sale items become a charge to your member account. Also, loyalty points are not added when you make a payment on your account, only when you actually purchase (or charge) a cart, merchandise and when you are billed membership dues (all pre-tax). Another note for snackbar charges-tabs accumulated at events charged at the Pavilion are usually posted a week or two after the event. We try to note "pavilion tab" when this occurs. Also, on July 1 & 2, the snackbar computer was down so we had to enter the information later in the week-dates may be off for those charges as well. Gotta love computers-actually I do:)

We love our new carts and hope you do too. The new cart keys have been dwindling so just a friendly reminder to leave the key in the cart when you are finished playing. If a key accidentally made it home with you we would love to add it back to our inventory.


Our next major event is the Member-Guest to be played on August 18/19. This will be the fun match around format with the pairings party taking place on Friday night, August 17, at 6 pm.

LOYALTY NOTICE FOR MEMBERS

Loyalty points reset on Jan 1 each year. UNUSED points expire annually midnight on Dec. 31.

One loyalty point is earned for each dollar spent (pretax) on golf carts, user fees, pro shop merchandise and membership dues. Food and beverage sales are not included at this time. UNUSED points expire annually at midnight on December 31. **LOYALTY POINTS** (REWARDS) may be redeemed as follows:

18 hole cart -350 pts-pay \$2 user fee (\$14 discount) 9 hole cart-200 pts-pay \$2 user fee (\$10 discount) Guest fee - 350 pts -pay \$4 user fee and guest cart fee (see chart below)

Merchandise:

Clothing-400 points=40% total discount Golf balls + gloves-400 points=20% total discount In stock golf clubs, shoes + special orders must see Bray for pricing

400 points = pay cost + 10%

A manual point adjustment will be made for merchandise discounts.
