## LOYALTY NOTICE FOR MEMBERS

Loyalty points reset on Jan 1 each year. UNUSED points expire annually midnight on Dec. 31.

One loyalty point is earned for each dollar spent (pretax) on golf carts, user fees, pro shop merchandise and membership dues. Food and beverage sales are not included at this time. UNUSED points expire annually at midnight on December 31

LOYALTY POINTS (REWARDS) may be redeemed as

18 hole cart -350 pts-pay \$2 user fee (\$14 discount) 9 hole cart-200 pts-pay \$2 user fee (\$10 discount) Guest fee – 350 pts -pay \$4 user fee and guest cart fee (see chart below)

(\$10 off price)

Merchandise:

Clothing-400 points=40% total discount Golf balls + gloves-400 points=20% total discount In stock golf clubs, shoes + special orders must see Bray for pricing

400 points = pay cost + 10%

A manual point adjustment will be made for merchandise discounts.
