**LOYALTY NOTICE FOR MEMBERS**

Loyalty points reset on Jan 1 each year.  
**UNUSED points expire annually midnight on Dec. 31.**

One loyalty point is earned for each dollar spent (pre-tax) on golf carts, user fees, pro shop merchandise and membership dues. Food and beverage sales are not included at this time. UNUSED points expire annually at midnight on December 31.

**LOYALTY POINTS (REWARDS)** may be redeemed as follows:  
 18 hole cart -350 pts-pay \$2 user fee (\$14 discount)  
 9 hole cart-200 pts-pay \$2 user fee (\$10 discount)  
 Guest fee - 350 pts -pay \$4 user fee and guest cart fee (see chart below)

Merchandise:  
 Clothing-400 points=40% total discount  
 Golf balls + gloves-400 points=20% total discount  
 In stock golf clubs, shoes + special orders must see Bray for pricing  
 400 points = pay cost + 10%  
 A manual point adjustment will be made for merchandise discounts.
