From the Office

We are feeling Springtime very early this year with the grass already beginning to green up and grow. "Tommy's" (Scruggs) Bridge on hole #18 was replaced last month and it has certainly made a difference. Bo will be fertilizing the fairways soon and we're looking for ways to fix the water issues on the first 3 holes. We are continually looking for ways to better the course and appreciate your patience as we work out a plan to make improvements.

We are reviewing our rates. If you have a friend interested in joining now is a great time to consider referring them. Remember you will receive a statement credit up to \$100 for each full member you refer that joins. We are also reviewing our rain check policies/procedures and will have a revised plan in place by April. The \$2.00 (\$1.90 + .10 tax) user fee each adult member pays to play is included in your cart fee of \$12.00 (\$9.35 + .65 tax + \$2 UF) for 9 holes and \$16.00 (\$13.08 + .92 + \$2 UF) for 18 holes. Guests pay a \$4.00 user fee (\$3.80 + .20) incorporated in the guest fees at the register. The user fees were designed originally to help with capital improvements and later designated for our annual property tax budget. We have been very fortunate to have this money set aside for the enormous tax bills due each January. As a reminder the daily \$2.00 user fee is due each time a member walks or rides - one, two or 36 holes. Thank you for your support as we continue to look for ways to balance the ever-increasing

LOYALTY NOTICE FOR MEMBERS

Loyalty points reset on Jan 1 each year.

UNUSED points expire annually midnight on Dec. 31.

One loyalty point is earned for each dollar spent (pre-tax) on golf carts, user fees, pro shop merchandise and membership dues. Food and beverage sales are not included at this time. UNUSED points expire annually at midnight on December 31.

LOYALTY POINTS (REWARDS) may be redeemed as follows:

- 18 hole cart -350 pts-pay \$2 user fee (\$14 discount)
- 9 hole cart—200 pts-pay \$2 user fee (\$10 discount)
- Guest fee – 350 pts -pay \$4 user fee and guest cart fee (see chart below)

Merchandise:

- Clothing-400 points=40% total discount
- Golf balls + gloves-400 points=20% total discount
- In stock golf clubs, shoes + special orders must see Bray for pricing
- 400 points = pay cost + 10%
- A manual point adjustment will be made for merchandise discounts.

MEMBER CART RATE SPECIALS

DAILY—Twilight member cart rate begins at 3/4 DST—\$12 for up to 18 holes. No rainchecks issued after 3 PM unless inclement weather forces course closure.

TUESDAY and WEDNESDAY—\$12 for 18 holes anytime
