#### NOTICE FOR MEMBERS – updated 5/01/2019

One loyalty point is earned for each dollar spent (pre-tax) on golf carts, user fees, pro shop merchandise and membership dues. Food & beverage sales are not included at this time. <u>UNUSED points expire annually at midnight on Dec 31.</u>

# LOYALTY POINTS (REWARDS) may be redeemed as follows: MEMBER CARTS:

18 hole cart – 400 points = pay \$2.00 user fee only (\$16 discount)

9 hole/twilight (after 3) cart – 250 points = pay \$2.00 user fee only (\$10 disc)

NOTE-MEMBER SPECIAL on Tues & Wed – ride 18 for \$12.00 anytime.

GUEST FEE - 400 points = pay \$4.00 user fee + guest cart fee (see chart below)

#### <u>FOR YOUR GUEST playing golf with you - USING 400 POINTS PER GUEST FEE:</u> Guest with CART:

Weekday riding rate \$29.00 = \$18.00 discounted rate (\$11 off price) Weekday riding rate \$34.00 = \$23.00 discounted rate (\$11 off price) Weekend riding rate \$39.00 = \$20.00 discounted rate (\$19 off price)

Weekday walking rate \$22.00 = \$4.00 discounted rate (\$18 off price) Weekend walking rate \$27.00 = \$4.00 discounted rate (\$23 off price) 9 + 100 = \$4.00 rate (\$11 off price)
