From the Office

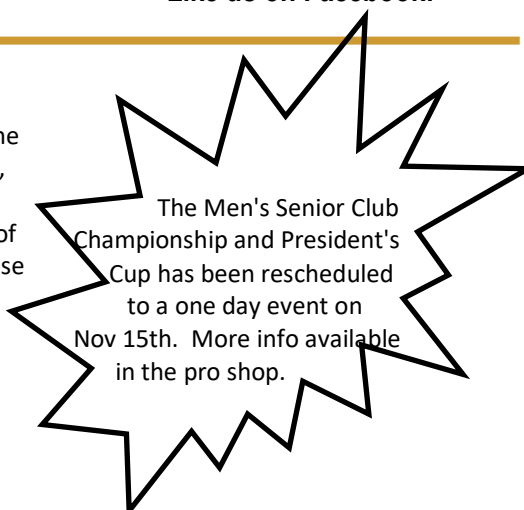

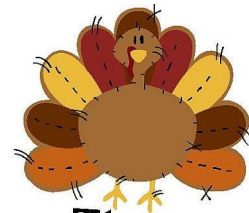
