

Loyalty Points Expire

REMINDER— full member referral credit has been increased to \$100 per each new full member you endorse. (\$25 credit for a seasonal new member, \$50 for a new social member and \$100 for a full new member). Please make sure you sign the referral on the application!

NOTICE FOR MEMBERS – updated 5/01/2019

One loyalty point is earned for each dollar spent (pre-tax) on golf carts, user fees, pro shop merchandise and membership dues. Food & beverage sales are not included at this time. <u>UNUSED points expire annually at midnight on Dec 31.</u>

LOYALTY POINTS (REWARDS) may be redeemed as follows: MEMBER CARTS:

18 hole cart – 400 points = pay \$2.00 user fee only (\$16 discount) 9 hole/twilight (after 3) cart – 250 points = pay \$2.00 user fee only (\$10 disc) NOTE-MEMBER SPECIAL on Tues & Wed – ride 18 for \$12.00 anytime. GUEST FEE - 400 points = pay \$4.00 user fee + guest cart fee (see chart below) FOR YOUR GUEST playing golf with you - USING 400 POINTS PER GUEST FEE: Guest with CART:

Weekday riding rate \$29.00 = \$18.00 discounted rate (\$11 off price) Weekday riding rate \$34.00 = \$23.00 discounted rate (\$11 off price) Weekend riding rate \$39.00 = \$20.00 discounted rate (\$19 off price) <u>Guest WALKING:</u>

Weekday walking rate \$22.00 = \$4.00 discounted rate (\$18 off price) Weekend walking rate \$27.00 = \$4.00 discounted rate (\$23 off price) <u>9 holes/twilight walking</u> rate-daily \$15.00 = \$4.00 rate (\$11 off price)

NO POINTS DISCOUNT FOR the following GUEST RIDING RATES: -9 HOLES OR TWILIGHT RATES with cart -JUNIOR OR COLLEGE RATES with cart

Tuesday and Wednesday ride 18 for \$12.00 anytime. Thursdays -Bring a guest to play golf for the same rate you pay-per person fee.

PRO SHOP MERCHANDISE:

Clothing – 400 points = 40% total discount <u>per item</u>.

Golf balls / gloves – 400 points = 20% total discount <u>per item</u>.

For in stock golf clubs, shoes + special orders - must see Bray for pricing.

400 points = pay cost + 10% + shipping + sales tax

A manual point adjustment will be made in the office for loyalty points used for merchandise discounts.

NEW for Full Golf Members-Each Thursday your guests (accompanied by you) can play golf and pay the same rate as you-per person fee.
