"To Go" orders only are available at the bar entrance door or can be placed by calling (843) 873-2210 x4. Premises must be

vacated by 8:00 pm

- Water coolers have been removed from the course. You may bring your own NON-alcoholic beverages on premise but coolers are not allowed. Bottled beverages are also available for purchase at the club. Outside alcoholic beverages are NOT PERMITTED to be brought on premise at any time. We are currently allowed to sell unopened beer and wine from the snackbar entrance on a "to go" basis.
- Sandtraps will be played as a preferred lie as rakes have been removed from the course. Please smooth area with your foot or club after hitting.
- Leave the flagstick in-cups adjusted.
- No handshakes.
- Bring personal hand sanitizer.
- Consider walking.
- All golfers ride as a single we are waiting on clarification of family living in same home and arriving together to play
- Golf cart common areas are sanitized after play by our staff. Collect your own trash in the provided bag-dispose of in trash cans by the cart lot after playing.
