Summerville Country Club, Inc. TENNIS / PICKLEBALL CLUB RULES As of April 1, 2020

We are excited to have our clay Tennis court ready to play again and for the addition of three new clay Pickleball courts. We appreciate your membership and loyal support. Please review the rules below and have fun playing!

1. Due to the **Corona COVID19** outbreak social distancing is encouraged on the courts. Each player should use separate tennis/pickleball balls and singles play should be considered until further guidance from our SC Governor. Using the club courts are at your own risk.

2. Water coolers are not provided on the courts. Please plan accordingly.

3. The courts are for Tennis and Pickleball use only by members and their guests. No unauthorized paid athletic services permitted.

4. Tennis and Pickleball court reservations are recommended. Average court time is 1 hour for singles and 1.5 hours for doubles. You may call the Golf Pro Shop at 843-873-2210 extension 1 to reserve the courts. Children 12 and under must be supervised.

5. Proper tennis attire is required. Please wear tennis or soft soled shoes to play.

6. Members must check in the Golf Pro Shop before playing and register all tennis guests with them - \$5.00 per guest per visit will be due. Guest fees can be charged to your member account. Please have your membership card available. Members must accompany guests when playing.

7. If the clay courts have standing water anywhere on the surface, please do not play on them or attempt to dry the courts by brushing them.

8. As a courtesy to other members, <u>clay courts should be brushed and lined</u> <u>after each</u> <u>use</u>. consider brushing and lining the courts after play ONLY if you have your own gloves to wear when handling the tennis court equipment. The line master wheel and drag brush should be hanging on the fence on each set of courts. Please do not allow small children to play with the maintenance equipment. The club will provide maintenance on the courts after the last court time is played each day.

9. The court lights must be manually turned on. Please call the pro shop prior to closing before attempting to turn the lights on for the first time. Be sure to turn the lights off when you leave which should be no later than 10:00 pm. will **NOT** be turned on during the Corona virus outbreak period as our premises are to be vacated by 8:00 p.m.

10. Please clean up your area after playing.
