PRIVATE CART OWNERS are required to have a signed SCC policy form on file with the club – this pertains to all private cart owners whether or not you pay a separate trail fee to the club. If you have not completed a SCC cart form please call or email me for one. **Please be sure to always check in before going out to play to check course conditions, or restrictions and to pay the appropriate fees. The course closes at dark and all carts must be off the golf course by sunset.**

REPLAYS, SPECIALS & TWILIGHT (AFTER 3 PM) RATE

CLARIFICATION:

All of our cart fee rates are for 9 OR 18 holes ONLY. When we have special rates-for example- members ride for \$12 anytime on Tues & Weds and guests pay \$25 to ride at anytime on Tues-**the rates are only for 18 holes.** **REPLAYS**-must always check in before replay-9 holes riding for members are \$10 and \$12 for guests. 18 holes are \$16 for members (\$10 on Tues/Weds and after 3 pm Thurs-Mon) and \$18 for guests. **TWILIGHT after 3 pm**-members and guests pay the posted 9 HOLE rates and are allowed to play up to 18 holes ONLY for no extra fees. **We do not and never have had a "play and ride all day" rate.** Also, please note, non-tax dependent family of club members must pay posted green fees except for Thursdays-please see specials below.

Every Thursday-Members can bring a guest to play golf or tennis for the same rate you pay- per person fee.

Grill & Fryer opens SUN-THURS 11:00 am - 7:00 pm

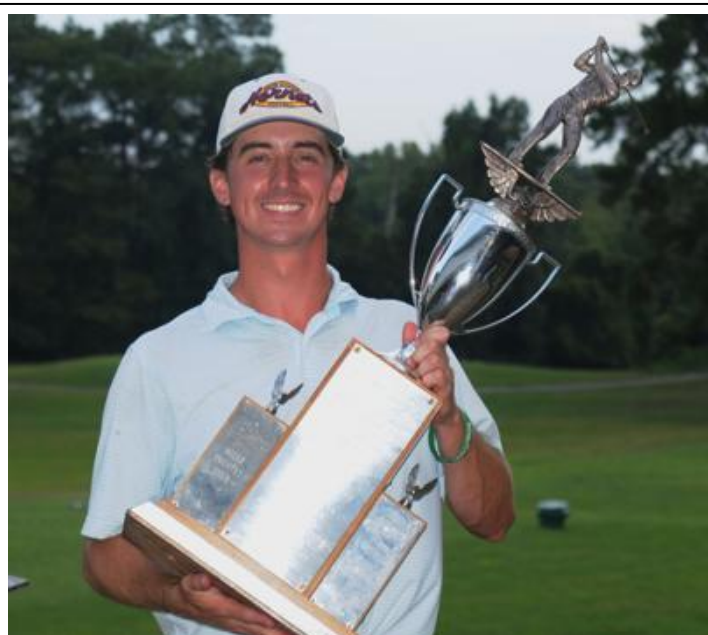

The pool key is available in the golf pro shop. Please consider calling in advance to make sure the pool is open.
