

SUMMERVILLE COUNTRY CLUB NOTICE

PRIVATE CART OWNERS are required to have a signed SCC policy form on file with the club – this pertains to <u>all</u> private cart owners whether or not you pay a separate trail fee to the club. If you have not completed a SCC cart form please call or email me for one. Please be sure to <u>always check in before going out to play</u> to find out course conditions or restrictions and to pay the appropriate fees. <u>The course closes at dark and all carts must be off the golf course before dark.</u>

REPLAYS, SPECIALS & TWILIGHT (10/01 AFTER 2 PM) RATE CLARIFICATION:

All of our cart fee rates are for 9 OR 18 holes ONLY. When we have special rates-for example- members ride for \$12 anytime on Tues & Weds and guests pay \$25 to ride at any time on Tues-the rates are for 18 holes only. We do not have a "play and ride all day" rate.

<u>REPLAYS</u> –must always check in before play. 9 holes with cart replay fee for members is \$10 and \$12 for guests. 18 holes replay fee with cart is \$16 for members (\$10 on Tues/Weds and after 2 pm Thurs-Mon) and \$18 for guests.

DAILY TWILIGHT after 2 pm-members and guests pay the 9 HOLE cart rates and are allowed to play <u>up to 18 holes **ONLY**</u> for no extra fees. Carts MUST be returned BEFORE dark. Last cart rented at 4:00 pm beginning 11/01/2020.

Also, please note, non-tax dependent family of club members must pay posted green fees except for Thursdays-please see specials below.

<u>Every Tues. & Wed. at anytime</u>-Members Golf & Ride 18 holes - \$12.00 <u>Every Thursday</u>-Member can bring a guest to play golf or tennis for the same rate you pay- per person fee.
