# 12<sup>th</sup> Annual Powerball 2021 Golf Tournament

### **SUPER BOWL SUNDAY, FEBRUARY 7**

12:00 Shotgun – Format is a four person Captain's Choice with a twist. Four holes randomly chosen by the pro at the beginning of play are designated "powerball" holes. Each member of the team gets one powerball hole to play. On the powerball hole, one member, chosen by the team to be that hole's powerball player, hits from the red tee box (or special tees if lady or junior). The catch is the shot from the "powerball" player must be the tee shot played by the group on that hole.

Entry Fee: \$75 per player, includes golf, prizes and Lowcountry Shrimp Boil served after play as "to go". Sign up in the prop – the field is limited to 120 players.
