## A NOTE FROM BO

Our course maintenance crew is outstanding and we are fortunate to have such a hardworking staff to keep our greens, tees, fairways and roughs in great shape. We are looking forward for our newer model greens mower to arrive, hopefully by early summer.

We have added sand to all of the traps and are working on drainage and irrigation. We really appreciate your help in avoiding the roped off areas as we are constantly working on storm water run-off in our low-lying areas.

The result of our new poa treatment that was applied three times over the past six weeks is anxiously being observed-the process is a delicate balance between timing, weather temps and rain.

Rakes have been replaced in the bunkers and we ask that you help us out by raking your steps if you land in the traps. We will not be replacing the water coolers on the course.

Greens aerification is set for June 1, 2021. The course will be closed that day.

## **BRAY'S BOGEYS**

March gave us great opportunities to get out and play and April looks to be even better. The Masters is back in April this year and always seems to inspire all of us to get out and play more. The supply chain for golf is unfortunately still a little behind but there are currently some great deals to take advantage of while manufacturers get caught up. Titleist and Callaway are both running buy 3 dozen get 1 free on their premium balls - lead times are currently around 6-8 weeks and orders need to be placed by April 18. We are still waiting on some of the new merchandise to come in but I expect by mid-April to have some new clubs and accessories in the shop.

Our first two major club tournaments are coming up in May with the Club Championship May 15-16 and the Chick Miler May 28-30. Match Play is scheduled to begin in June.
