Notes from the office -

Recently an article in GOLF COURSE INDUSTRY was left on my desk. The article was titled "DEAR NEW GOLFER" and it addressed new golfers who have taken up the game, or returned to it, during the pandemic. The author, Tim Moraghan, listed some rules he referred to as "givens" that should be followed to keep the course in better shape for you and the players behind you.

- FILL YOUR DIVOT....pour the sand provided in the bottle on your cart on the scrape and smooth and tamp it down BELOW the level of the turf. This will best help the turf recover without the sand damaging the mower reels.
- 2. REPAIR BALL MARKS...AND NOT JUST YOURS.
- 3. FIND THE BUNKER RAKE AND USE IT.
- 4. FOLLOW THE RULES ABOUT CART PATHS....they are there for a reason and help protect and preserve the course.
- 5. MAINTAIN PACE OF PLAY.
- DON'T ASK FOR WHAT YOU CAN'T HANDLE....don't demand that your superintendent create course conditions that neither you nor your club budget can handle.
- 7. LEARN A LITTLE ABOUT WHAT IT TAKES TO KEEP THE COURSE IN SHAPE. Don't be afraid to ask your superintendent or golf pro questions about course maintenance.
- 8. REMEMBER THE GOLDEN RULE....."do unto others as you would have done to you." Think of other golfers following you and leave the course in the best possible condition, be nice, tolerant, and patient. Much more than skill, golf commands civility and sportsmanship.


<u>SAFETY FIRST:</u> Please drive carts slowly when approaching the clubhouse. The pool is open increasing the number of children in area.
