In the New Year, we are going to transition to a new credit card processing company. As you may have seen on TV, credit card processing fees are rising almost daily. We have decided to go with a new card processor that directly collects fees associated with credit card transactions from the customer by adding the fee to the sale, by-passing us. The rate charged per transaction will be a low 3.5% or .35 per \$10.00. The good news is that there is no extra charge if you pay by check or cash. This program is referred to as a "Cash Discount" sale. We are also reviewing our current rates and will make slight adjustments by the end of Feb 2022.
