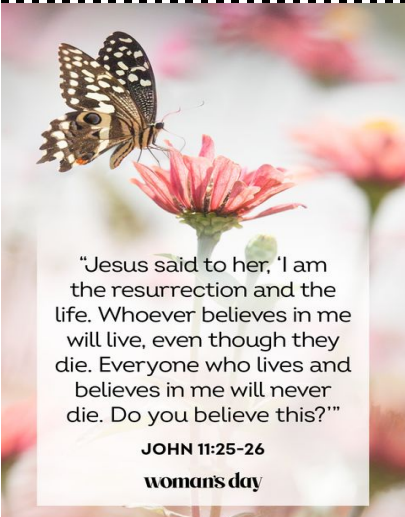

GOLF ACCOMPLISHMENTS

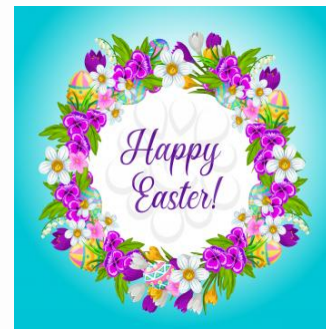
3/19/25 Steve Chellis shot a 74, one under his age.
