**Powerball** is a four man Captain's Choice format with a twist. Four holes randomly chosen by the golf pro at the beginning of play are designated "powerball" holes. Each member of the team gets one powerball hole. On the powerball hole the player chosen by the team to be the powerball player hits from the red tee box (special tees for junior / lady powerball). The catch is the shot from the powerball player **must be the tee shot** played by the team on that hole. **ENTRY FEE \$50 per member \$60 per guest** – includes golf, prizes & cookout after play.
